

2. A

- Savannah is not only famed for its rich history and hospitality, but also for its numerous ghost stories and haunted tours, which earned it this reputation.

3. D

- All of the options represent popular downtown Savannah attractions. Visitors can enjoy horse-drawn carriage rides, riverboat cruises, and ghost tours, all showcasing the city's historic charm and haunted legends.

4. D

- The Irish were among Savannah's first settlers, which is why the city hosts one of the largest St. Patrick's Day parades in the country.

5. A

- The Girl Scouts were founded in Savannah, Georgia, in 1912 by Juliette Gordon Low, who started the group in her hometown to help girls build confidence, leadership, and community service skills.

6. B

- The first and only Prohibition themed museum in the country opened in Savannah in May 2017: the American Prohibition Museum. It's no dry establishment either, with a password you also get access to the speakeasy.

7. C

- The Globe is a landmark in Midtown Savannah, Georgia. Once an eyesore, it was repainted in 1999. It was originally the World Globe Gas Storage Tank. If you look, the mailbox is the moon!

- Based on the Harlem Globetrotters' style, The Savannah Bananas focus on fun, showmanship, comedy, dance, and fan participation to make the game more entertaining and enjoyable for everyone."
